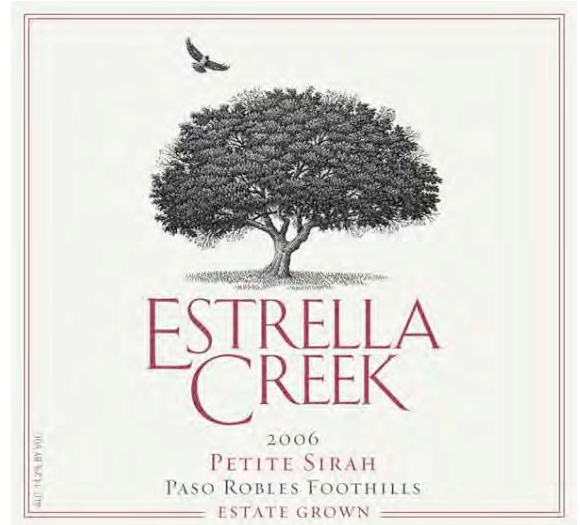


ESTRELLA CREEK WINES

2006 PETITE SIRAH

CELLARING: Enjoyable immediately, but will age gracefully over the next several years. Enjoy by 2016.

GROWING CONDITIONS: Spring 2006 was unusually wet with significant rainfall continuing until June. Although a warm, pleasant summer was punctuated by a blazing 10-day stretch in mid-July, harvest began on schedule. Vines reinvigorated by late Spring rains and judicious cluster thinning resulted in lush, incredibly rich wines.

WINEMAKING: Hand harvested. Must was pumped over twice daily for 14 days then sealed for 10 days of additional maceration prior to pressing. After fermentation, wine aged in American new and neutral oak barrels for 26 months prior to bottling.
