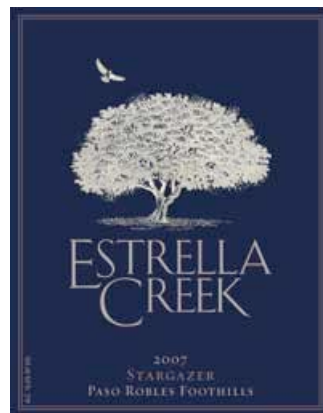


ESTRELLA CREEK WINES

2007 STARGAZER



VARIETAL: 70% Syrah, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Petite Sirah

APPELLATION: Paso Robles, CA (Estrella area)

VINEYARD: Syrah & Petite Sirah 4M Vineyards/ Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles

HARVEST DATE: September 9 & October 15, 2007

BRIX AT HARVEST: 26.5 & 26

ALCOHOL: 15.0%

ACIDITY: 0.67g/100mL

PH: 3.63

RESIDUAL SUGAR: 0.04g/100mL

DATE BOTTLED: November 16, 2010

CASES BOTTLED: 250

CELLARING: Our 2007 Stargazer is readily approachable and will age elegantly to 2018.

GROWING CONDITIONS: A cold, dry winter and spring led to early budbreak. January's record cold (10-day stretch with nighttime low temperatures at 15 degrees) and lack of rainfall led to extremely small crop characterized by miniscule clusters which ultimately resulted in lush, incredibly rich wines.

TASTING NOTES: Dark ruby color. Bouquet of ripe cherries and anise. Taste of dark chocolate and cherries; deep tannins and a long, warm finish along the roof of your mouth. Decant this wine, as it becomes more interesting and complex as it continues to open.

WINEMAKING: Grapes are hand-harvested, destemmed and crushed into stainless steel fermentors. Wines are aged for 24 months in French, American and/or Hungarian barrels prior to bottling.
